Cave rescue team's co-operation

Workshop and cave rescue practising
8th - 11th of October, 2009

Report of the event

The event was organised on the availability of joint operation of different cave rescue team's on the same accident, under common leadership as the participants have some common or relatively closely located karst areas.

All the participants described their organisation's work during a real rescue operation and at the end they received a good point of view about the chance of further common operations.

The event was organised between 8 and 11 October in Hungary, on Bankút in the Bükk Mountain.

The first part of the event was a workshop, the second part is a rescue practising together - under common leadership with mixed teams.

The site of the meeting was organised by the Hungarian Cave Rescue Service with a local caver club - as well as the other necessary components (dining, equipment of rescue practising, equipment of lectures, etc.).

The guest participants came from four different countries as Poland, Serbia, Romania and Slovakia - and of course the hosts were from Hungary - that is way this event was a good opportunity to get together cavers from five different countries (within EU and beyond EU as well).

Before the event we received the support from FSE - as 500 ms BEAL rope - we used this amount of rope during the rescue practice.
